

WAER WATERS FACTSHEET

1. Company Description

Short version

Waer Waters is the largest wellness resort in the Benelux, located in Dilbeek, just outside Brussels. Since 2012, the resort has offered a place where relaxation, movement and gastronomy come together in a 12,000 m² architectural total concept. Visitors enjoy thermal facilities, sports infrastructure, a hotel and culinary experiences in an environment that breathes calm and luxury.

Long version

Waer Waters is a 4-star hotel and wellness resort in Dilbeek, near Brussels, and is recognized as the largest wellness complex in the Benelux. Since opening in 2012, it has grown into a destination where wellbeing is embraced as a lifestyle.

The 12,000 m² resort combines wellness, sports, beauty, hospitality and gastronomy in an architectural setting designed to slow down and unwind. Large glass façades, natural materials and water as a central element create an environment where guests can disconnect from the pace of everyday life.

The offering is aimed at day visitors, hotel guests and regular members who want to integrate relaxation into their routine. Waer Waters stands for experience, tranquility and quality, with continuous investments in new facilities and wellness innovations.

2. Family Vision

Waer Waters is a family business, founded by the Coppens family and managed by CEO Sarah Coppens. The vision behind the resort is rooted in the idea of a balanced lifestyle, where effort and relaxation reinforce one another.

Water forms the heart of the concept. Hydrotherapy, alternating heat and cold, and moments of silence help the body recover and calm the mind. Waer Waters aims to be a place where visitors reconnect with themselves, away from daily pressure, in an environment that feels both luxurious and accessible.

- Unite – clothed zone with saunas, hammams, pools and infusion rituals
- Zen – clothed whisper zone focused on silence and deep relaxation
- Re-energise – nude zone for experienced wellness enthusiasts
